

EXHIBITOR AGREEMENT

1. Exhibitors must be proponents of private, independent homeschooling to be a vendor at the conference. And can not be under the jurisdiction of a charter school or public school ISP in their own homeschooling efforts.

2. Exhibitors acknowledge that spaces are 8'x10', organized according to the enclosed map, which is subject to change. Sacramento Christian Organization of Parent Educators (SCOPE) reserves the right to final assignment of booth space.

3. Exhibitors may use their own tables. Table draping or other display material must be professional quality, of flame-proof fabric approved for such use. Displays may not extend beyond the confines of the exhibit space and cannot interfere with the visibility or operation of adjoining tables and aisles.

4. SCOPE reserves the right to refuse exhibit space to any registries/applicant for any reason.

5. SCOPE reserves the right to require removal of any material or display which in SCOPE's judgment is offensive or inappropriate, or inconsistent with our principles, purposes, or Christian statement of faith. Please, review your materials for items which would be offensive to our primarily Christian conventioners and eliminate them from your displays. Such items would include: Stories or art work which contain witches, ghosts, dragons, astrology, or other occult symbols, science material based on evolution; New age or overtly humanistic material; Values Clarification curriculum; fantasy role playing games or curriculum; or any material which portray Christianity as untrue, the Bible as merely mythological, or Christianity as one among many equal religions. Our receipt of this signed agreement implies your understanding of and agreement to these terms and releases SCOPE from any financial or other liability related to such exclusion or removal.

6. Only those items specified on the Exhibitor Agreement may be displayed. Exhibitor may not display material from other companies, unless specifically approved by SCOPE prior to the event.

7. Courtesy is expected of all exhibitors, at all times. Audio tapes and video monitors are permitted to enhance or facilitate your display; however, such equipment must be kept at a reasonably low volume. Please remember if you need power, etc., bring your own grounded extension cord to plug into perimeter outlets. SCOPE may prohibit the use of audio/visual equipment if its use results in complaints from surrounding booths or conference attendees.

8. Exhibitors will be issued name tags, or bracelets, that must be worn at all times in the building.

9. Exhibitors cannot have shipments arrive prior to date of conference Friday, May 30,

2008. SCOPE will not be financially or liable in any way if shipments arrive and are turned away, stolen, or damaged before Friday, May 30, 2008.

Exhibitors may set up and tear down only when the Exhibit Hall is closed to the public. Special situations must be approved by SCOPE prior to the event. Details for move-in and move-out will accompany your confirmation packet.

SECURITY:

1. SCOPE shall not be held responsible for any loss, damage, injury or theft that may occur during the event. Exhibits must be staffed at all times. If the vendor representative is alone and needs a break or is doing a workshop, the exhibitor must provide a volunteer to watch the booth.

2. Any damage to the building due to carelessness or misconduct of an exhibitor or their volunteers will be paid for by same. No materials may be stapled, taped, glued, tacked or otherwise affixed to the building except by use of "Construction Masking" tape.

HOSPITALITY:

There will be one free lunch per vendor, and you are welcome to purchase more. Vendor must pre-order additional lunches by April 15, 2008. Payment of additional lunches will be required upon receiving lunch. Food is permitted in Exhibitor Booths. (A restaurant map will be in your conformation packet.) We will also have a snack cart for vendors.

INDEMNIFICATION:

Exhibitor shall indemnify and hold SCOPE harmless from and against any and all claims and/or liabilities arising from Exhibitor's use of exhibit space or from the conduct of Exhibitor, its employees or agents, work or things done, permitted or suffered by Exhibitor in or about its exhibit space or elsewhere on or in the facility covered by this agreement. Exhibitor further agrees to indemnify and hold SCOPE harmless from and against all cost, attorney's fees, expenses and liabilities incurred in the defense of any such claim or any action or proceeding brought thereon.

ATTORNEY FEES:

In the event suit or action is brought by any party under this agreement to enforce any of its terms, it is agreed that the prevailing party shall be entitled to a reasonable

attorney fee to be fixed by the trial and appellate court.

LICENSES:

Any and all City, Municipal, State, or Federal licenses, inspections or permits as required by law of any Exhibitor in the installation or operation of his/her display shall be obtained by the Exhibitor at its own expense prior to the opening of the event.

AMENDMENTS:

Exhibitor agrees to abide by decisions of SCOPE concerning all matters pertaining to the administration and success of the conference which are not specifically stated.

INSURANCE: (Please check one):

Exhibitor acknowledges that SCOPE does not maintain insurance covering exhibitors' property and that it is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to obtain business interruption and/or property damage insurance covering such losses by the exhibitor.

CONFIRMATION:

Confirmation of having a booth(s) will come through the mail or email by the middle of February 2008, signing this agreement does not guarantee a booth.

CANCELLATION:

A 20% cancellation fee will be charged for cancellations before April 15, 2008.

No refunds after April 15, 2008.
